DECEMBER 2018

- 2nd FRIENDS OF CHILDREN IN ROMANIA is based in the Carpathian mountains in eastern Romania. There are three homes in the village of Harja. The Charity offers: a secure and happy home to children who have none. A home where each child can be loved and cared for as an individual. A home where each care for one another as in families they don't possess. The first children came to the charity out of the notorious orphanages of the communist regime. These children are now grown up, at university and in training. Father Martin has supported the charity for many years.
- 9th SUSSEX SNOWDROP TRUST provides care at home for children with life threatening and terminal illnesses.
- 16 ^{THE}CHILDREN'S SOCIETY is a Church of England society raising funds and awareness for children in poverty.

- STONEPILLOW works with homeless and vulnerable people in the Chichester area towards inclusion and wellbeing. Stonepillow Chichester Hostel, St. Joseph's provides overnight accommodation for homeless people. The new Bognor Hostel provides short-term accommodation and support in a and safe and stable environment for 14 residents. There is intensive support to enable clients to start achieving stability and move on to more suitable accommodation.
- 30th THE FOUNDATION FOR RELIEF AND RECONCILIATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST (FRMME) is a small UK based charity founded in 2005. Since its inception FRRME has worked to bridge the sectarian divide in the Middle East through Interfaith dialogue and by providing emergency relief to those who have been apart by war.

6th St. Wilfrid's Hospice offers specialist care to patients at home, in hospital and in the Hospice. DREAMBUILDING, St. Wilfrid's new hospice for the 21st century will open its doors during 2019.

13th LIFE CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION – The Promise Centre, Mozambique cares for orphaned, abandoned, HIV street children from very poor backgrounds.

20th SAGE HOUSE DEMENTIA SUPPORT is a young and exciting West Sussex charity based in Tangmere. It works with voluntary and charitable organisations, the NHS, West Sussex County Council and other statutory organisations to create a unique community hub for dementia to enhance the well-being and quality of life for local people living with dementia, their families and carers.

27th CHURCH URBAN FUND working with churches and community groups to tackle poverty in England's most deprived areas.

FEBRUARY

3rd MADHYA KERALA DIOCESE to help people and families in the Diocese who suffered from the floods in August 2018.

10th SAMARA'S AID APPEAL This is a small, local charity providing medical aid in the containers taken to Syria and left there having delivered humanitarian aid collected in a warehouse in Worthing for displaced and traumatised people, refugees and victims of war in Syria and the Middle East.

17th VOICES OF EXILE (BVIE) The Diocesan appeal through VIE Brighton to support refugees coming to Sussex for resettlement in the county.

24th BEATS was set up following the 2004 Boxing Day tsunami which claimed many lives over a vast area. The charity is principally working in Sumatra, Indonesia, providing financial support for education, food and other needs for victims of earthquakes and tsunamis. They presently have an appeal for victims of the earthquake and tsunami in Sulawesi, Indonesia in September 2018 in which it is thought thousands have perished.
